



SSAF GRANT PROGRAM

CLUB APPLICATION GUIDELINES

Melbourne University Sport is encouraging all University affiliated Sporting Clubs to seek additional program funding through the SSAF Grant Scheme.

The purpose of the Grant Program is to offer funding for **student focussed** initiatives that contribute to **meeting the needs of the University's diverse student population**. Currently around \$1.5million in contingency funds are available for distribution.

It is recommended and encouraged that Club's apply directly to the Scheme but so note however that MU Sport is available to provide advice on appropriate content.

The current grant round has been open since Monday 13 August, 2018 and will close on Monday 10 September 2018. All submission requirements and application forms are available online.

Melbourne University Sport recommend that any applications should be submitted on behalf of a club either by a Student Committee Member or General Club Member, as this would be seen as more favorable by the selection committee.

Support Services are offered by the University to help guide any applicants through the process and as previously stated, MU Sport will consult with Clubs should they require advice at any stage. This can be arranged through the Clubs Coordinator (contact information below).
